



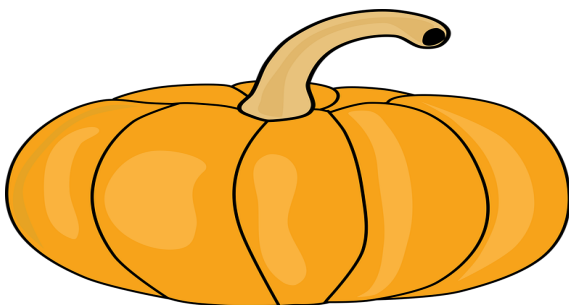

Crossing Guard's Corner

As the South Park Elementary School Crossing Guard, I am charged with instructing our scholars in the safe practices of crossing the street when coming and departing from class each day. I have an issue that is causing me grave concern and that is the issue of "Jaywalking". I have observed a number of parents/guardians, etc., crossing in the middle of the block on both Hollywood Drive and Farabaugh Lane at various times in the morning and afternoon, especially when there are younger siblings in tow. Please use either the crosswalk at the corner of Hollywood and Farabaugh, the crosswalk east of Hollywood on Farabaugh, or the crosswalk south of Farabaugh on Hollywood near the kindergarten rooms to cross the street. Although there is no guard at either of the two latter crosswalks, it is far safer than jaywalking. This will also serve to instill in your youngsters the fact that jaywalking is dangerous. It is far better to arrive a few minutes later than not to arrive at all.
